Indemnification. Governing Law and Jurisdiction**. The laws of Connecticut shall govern and the courts of Connecticut shall interpret this Agreement. **6. Binding Agreement.** This Agreement shall legally bind me, and my family members, spouse, estate, heirs, administrators, or personal representatives. 7. Severability. If a court decides that any part of this Agreement cannot be enforced, I agree to change that part to make it enforceable. If the unenforceable part cannot legally be changed, it will be severed, but the rest of the Agreement will remain in effect. 8. Signature. I agree that I have read and understood this Agreement, I am competent to sign it, and I do so voluntarily and without relying on anything Yale wrote or told me except what is written above. I understand that I am free not to sign this Agreement and to find a different program in which to participate. Before you sign this Agreement, please read it carefully because it affects your legal rights.
